ECONOMIC IMPACTS OF THE WILDS




The Wilds is a nonprofit safari park and conservation center located in Cumberland, Ohio. The mission of The Wilds is to lead and inspire by connecting people and wildlife.

- In 2021, The Wilds hosted **112,608 visitors,** primarily from Ohio and parts of West Virginia.
- The Wilds' core group of employees come from a 7-county region, including Coshocton, Guernsey, Licking, Morgan, Muskingum, Noble and Perry Counties
- The Wilds contributes over \$26 million to the regional economy
- For every 3 employees at The Wilds, 1 additional full-time job is supported in the regional economy through supply chain effects and the spending of income
- Almost \$9 and a half million in wages are paid to workers as a result of The Wilds' activity.
- The Wilds helps support several jobs in **other key regional industries** such as restaurants, real estate, employment services, and warehousing, among others

- Located on nearly 10,000 acres of reclaimed coal mine land in Guernsey and Muskingum Counties
- One of the largest wildlife conservation centers in North America
- Open daily from May through September, weekends in October, with Winter at The Wilds tours offered throughout the winter months
- Available activities include fishing, horseback, zipline, open-air safari tours, and other workshops and events
- The Conservation Science Training Center offers facilities for science workshops, apprentice teaching, etc.
- Overnight accommodations include Nomad Ridge, The Lodge, and Straker Lake







