Dear Community Member,

Thank you for choosing a Wilds Outreach Program. Please review this packet carefully as it contains important helpful information to prepare for our visit:

Payment: Final payment is required two weeks in advance. To arrange payment, please reach out to (740) 638-5030 ext. 2029. Each Outreach program has a maximum of 35 participants per session; multiple sessions may be booked on the same day. The price per session is \$35.00.

Mileage: Federal mileage rate is added to any program outside of Muskingum, Guernsey, Noble, and Morgan Counties. This cost will be due at the time of final payment.

Minimum Age: Our curriculum meets Ohio State Standards for grades 2nd-4th but sessions may be adjusted to fit both younger (to kindergarten age) and older students up to grade 8. Special accommodation can be provided for neurodivergent learners.

Set Up Requests: Most of our programs contain audio visual components and are best for classroom or other school settings (cafeteria, gym, etc.) with access to Wi-Fi and audio-visual equipment (projector, screen, whiteboard, etc.). However, our programs can be adapted to non-electronic options with advanced notice.

Cancellation Policy: All cancellations are subject to processing fees. Cancellations must be made at least two weeks in advance to receive an 80% refund. Quoted mileage will be reimbursed in full. Cancellations made less than two weeks in advance are non-refundable.

Weather: If school is canceled due to weather or road conditions are hazardous for travel, we will reschedule the program to another day, free of charge.

Additional Information: Due to the nature of our collection, no live animals will be used during the program.

FOR 2ND - 4TH GRADERS




BUG OUT:

This one-hour program incorporates hands-on games and activities incorporating English Language Arts and Science Standards to educate 2nd - 4th graders about the difference between bugs and insects, basic insect body parts, life cycles, and more.



ENDANGERED SPECIES:

This one-hour program incorporates hands-on games and activities incorporating English Language Arts and Science Standards to educate 2nd - 4th grade students about endangered species worldwide and in Ohio. Learn about the exotic endangered species managed at The Wilds, native endangered species, what causes them to become endangered, and what can be done or is being done to protect them.



FEATHERS, FUR, AND SCALES:

This one-hour program incorporates hands-on games and activities incorporating English Language Arts and Science Standards to educate 2nd - 4th grade students about animal coverings, the differences between mammals, birds, and reptiles/amphibians and understand how these different coverings help them survive in different environments.



MORE THAN A NIGHT OWL:

This one-hour program incorporates hands-on games and activities incorporating English Language Arts and Science Standards to educate 2nd - 4th grade students about **nocturnal and diurnal animals**, how they communicate and adapt to living at night.
